## Four-Question Test / Rest of the Book

Looking back (last week):
Ao Ask, "What are your main "takeaways" from the lessons this past week?"
$\partial_{\infty}$ Go over the completed Quiz or give it as an open-book test
$\infty$ Ask if anyone has thoughts to share about the Self-Evaluation (Will You Be Wise) on page 215
\& Have everyone select one of their three proverbs and tell how they went "deeper" with it.

- Which design of the two-line proverb was used? (page 213)
- Which of the four kinds of wisdom was used, Knowledge, Understanding, Instruction, or Discretion. (pages 213 \& 214)
$\infty$ Find out if anyone used the four-question test for a decision they need to make?

Optional Activity:
$\infty$ Ask for volunteers who have a decision to make. Make sure they don't mind sharing it with others. There should be at least two volunteers.
$\infty$ Assure the volunteers they will be happy they took advantage of this opportunity to hear advice.
$\infty$ Put the volunteers in various corners of the room (with eight or less people around them). Everyone in the class should join one of the groups.
$\infty$ Each volunteer should briefly describe the decision they need to make. Limit this part of the activity to five minutes. Explain that it's not important that their group knows all the details.
$\infty$ Each team is to take the volunteer through the Four-Question Test found in lesson 4.
$\infty^{\infty}$ This activity will take up the rest of the time for the group meeting. Allow enough time for each team to report how their session went.
